1 SEC. 2. LOAN CANCELLATION. 2 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 465(a) of the Higher 3 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087ee(a)) is amend-4 ed— 5 (1) in paragraph (2)— (A) by striking "section 111(c)" in sub-6 7 "section paragraph (A) and inserting 8 1113(a)(5)"; (B) by striking "or" at the end of subpara-9 10 graph (H); 11 (C) by striking the period at the end of 12 subparagraph (I) and inserting "; or"; and 13 (D) by inserting after subparagraph (I) the 14 following new subparagraph: 15 "(J) as a full time librarian, if the librarian has 16 a master's degree in library science and is employed 17 in— "(i) an elementary school or secondary 18 19 school that is eligible for assistance under title 20 I of the Elementary and Secondary Education 21 Act of 1965; or "(ii) a public library that serves a geo-22 graphic area that contains 1 or more schools el-23 24 igible for assistance under title I of the Elemen-25 tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965."; 26 and

(2) in paragraph (3)(A)(i), by striking out
"(H), or (I)" and inserting "(H), (I), or (J)".
(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any year of serv ice that is completed after the date of enactment of this
Act.
