To amend part A of title XVIII of the Social Security Act to clarify that facilities designated as critical access hospitals may use beds certified for such hospitals for assisted living.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Enhanced Options for
- 5 Rural Health Care Act of 2007".

SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION REGARDING USE OF CRITICAL AC-2 CESS HOSPITAL BEDS FOR ASSISTED LIVING. 3 Section 1820(c) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 4 1320i–4(c)) is amended by adding at the end the following 5 new paragraph: 6 "(3) Clarification regarding use of cah 7 CERTIFIED BEDS FOR ASSISTED LIVING.—Nothing 8 in this title shall be construed as preventing a facility designated as a critical access hospital from 9 10 using any of its designated number of beds for pur-11 poses of providing assisted living and from accepting 12 private payments for services furnished in connec-13 tion with the use of such beds for such purpose. 14 However, such use shall not increase the total num-15 ber of beds that the facility may have and maintain
