A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a separate Veterans Integrated Service Network for the Gulf Coast region of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF GULF COAST VETERANS**
4 **INTEGRATED SERVICE NETWORK.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
6 shall establish a separate Veterans Affairs Service Net-
7 work (in this Act referred to as a “VISN”) for the Gulf
8 Coast region of the United States, to comprise the fol-
9 lowing counties:

1 (1) In the State of Florida, the counties of
2 Franklin, Liberty, Gulf, Calhoun, Jackson, Bay,
3 Washington, Holmes, Walton, Okaloosa, Santa
4 Rosa, and Escambia.

5 (2) In the State of Alabama, the counties of
6 Houston, Henry, Dale, Geneva, Coffee, Covington,
7 Conecuh, Escambia, Monroe, Baldwin, Clarke, Mo-
8 bile, and Washington.

9 (3) In the State of Mississippi, the counties of
10 Jackson, George, Harrison, Stone, Hancock, and
11 Pearl River.

12 (b) DEADLINE FOR ESTABLISHMENT.—The Sec-
13 retary shall establish the VISN specified in subsection (a)
14 not later than one year after the date of the enactment
15 of this Act.
