Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. RECLASSIFICATION OF CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY,

NEW YORK, FOR PURPOSES OF PAYMENT FOR

INPATIENT HOSPITAL SERVICES UNDER THE

MEDICARE PROGRAM.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, effective

for discharges occurring on or after September 30, 2007,

for purposes of making payments under section 1886(d)

10 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)) the

- 1 large urban area of Buffalo-Niagara Falls, New York is
- 2 deemed to include Chautauqua County, New York. For
- 3 purposes of that section, the reclassification under this
- 4 section shall be treated as a decision of the Medicare Geo-
- 5 graphic Classification Review Board under paragraph (10)
- 6 of that section, except that in no case shall there be a
- 7 reduction in the hospital wage index for Erie County, New
- 8 York, or any adjoining county, as a result of the applica-
- 9 tion of this section (other than as a result of a general
- 10 reduction required to carry out paragraph (10)(D) of that
