## A BILL

To safely redeploy United States troops from Iraq.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 (a) Transition of Mission.—The President shall
- 4 promptly transition the mission of United States forces
- 5 in Iraq to the limited purposes set forth in subsection (d).
- 6 (b) Commencement of Safe, Phased Redeploy-
- 7 MENT FROM IRAQ.—The President shall commence the
- 8 safe, phased redeployment of United States forces from
- 9 Iraq that are not essential to the limited purposes set forth

- 1 in subsection (d). Such redeployment shall begin not later
- 2 than 120 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 3 (c) Prohibition on Use of Funds.—No funds ap-
- 4 propriated or otherwise made available under any provi-
- 5 sion of law may be obligated or expended to continue the
- 6 deployment in Iraq of members of the United States
- 7 Armed Forces after March 31, 2008.
- 8 (d) Exception for Limited Purposes.—The pro-
- 9 hibition under subsection (c) shall not apply to the obliga-
- 10 tion or expenditure of funds for the limited purposes as
- 11 follows:
- 12 (1) To conduct targeted operations, limited in
- duration and scope, against members of al Qaeda
- and other international terrorist organizations.
- 15 (2) To provide security for United States infra-
- structure and personnel.
- 17 (3) To train and equip Iraqi security services.
