#### A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to convey to the McGee Creek Authority certain facilities of the McGee Creek Project, Oklahoma, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "McGee Creek Project
- 5 Pipeline and Associated Facilities Conveyance Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

3	(1) AGREEMENT.—The term "Agreement"					
4	means the agreement numbered 06–AG–60–211					
5	and entitled "Agreement Between the United State					
6	of America and McGee Creek Authority for the Pur					
7	pose of Defining Responsibilities Related to and Im					
8	plementing the Title Transfer of Certain Facilities					
9	at the McGee Creek Project, Oklahoma".					
10	(2) Authority.—The term "Authority" means					
11	the McGee Creek Authority located in Oklahoma					
12	City, Oklahoma.					
13	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means					
14	the Secretary of the Interior.					
15	SEC. 3. CONVEYANCE OF MCGEE CREEK PROJECT PIPE-					
16	LINE AND ASSOCIATED FACILITIES.					
17	(a) Authority To Convey.—					
18	(1) In general.—In accordance with all appli-					
19	cable laws and consistent with any terms and condi-					
20	tions provided in the Agreement, the Secretary may					
21	convey to the Authority all right, title, and interest					
22	of the United States in and to the pipeline and any					
23	associated facilities described in the Agreement, in-					
24	cluding—					

(A) the pumping plant;

1	(B) the raw water pipeline from the McGee					
2	Creek pumping plant to the rate of flow control					
3	station at Lake Atoka;					
4	(C) the surge tank;					
5	(D) the regulating tank;					
6	(E) the McGee Creek operation and main-					
7	tenance complex, maintenance shop, and pole					
8	barn; and					
9	(F) any other appurtenances, easements,					
10	and fee title land associated with the facilities					
11	described in subparagraphs (A) through (E), in					
12	accordance with the Agreement.					
13	(2) Exclusion of mineral estate from					
14	CONVEYANCE.—					
15	(A) In General.—The mineral estate					
16	shall be excluded from the conveyance of any					
17	land or facilities under paragraph (1).					
18	(B) Management.—Any mineral interests					
19	retained by the United States under this Act					
20	shall be managed—					
21	(i) consistent with Federal law; and					
22	(ii) in a manner that would not inter-					
23	fere with the purposes for which the					
24	McGee Creek Project was authorized.					

1	(3) Compliance with agreement; applica-
2	BLE LAW.—
3	(A) AGREEMENT.—All parties to the con-
4	veyance under paragraph (1) shall comply with
5	the terms and conditions of the Agreement, to
6	the extent consistent with this Act.
7	(B) APPLICABLE LAW.—Before any con-
8	veyance under paragraph (1), the Secretary
9	shall complete any actions required under—
10	(i) the National Environmental Policy
11	Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.);
12	(ii) the Endangered Species Act of
13	1973 (16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.);
14	(iii) the National Historic Preserva-
15	tion Act (16 U.S.C. 470 et seq.); and
16	(iv) any other applicable laws.
17	(b) Operation of Transferred Facilities.—
18	(1) IN GENERAL.—On the conveyance of the
19	land and facilities under subsection (a)(1), the Au-
20	thority shall comply with all applicable Federal,
21	State, and local laws (including regulations) in the
22	operation of any transferred facilities.
23	(2) Operation and maintenance costs.—
24	(A) In general.—After the conveyance of
25	the land and facilities under subsection $(a)(1)$

and consistent with the Agreement, the Authority shall be responsible for all duties and costs associated with the operation, replacement, maintenance, enhancement, and betterment of the transferred land and facilities.

(B) Limitation on funding.—The Authority shall not be eligible to receive any Federal funding to assist in the operation, replacement, maintenance, enhancement, and betterment of the transferred land and facilities, except for funding that would be available to any comparable entity that is not subject to reclamation laws.

#### (c) Release From Liability.—

- (1) IN GENERAL.—Effective beginning on the date of the conveyance of the land and facilities under subsection (a)(1), the United States shall not be liable for damages of any kind arising out of any act, omission, or occurrence relating to any land or facilities conveyed, except for damages caused by acts of negligence committed by the United States (including any employee or agent of the United States) before the date of the conveyance.
- (2) NO ADDITIONAL LIABILITY.—Nothing in this subsection adds to any liability that the United

3 (d) Contractual Obligations.—

- (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in paragraph (2), any rights and obligations under the contract numbered 0-07-50-X0822 and dated October 11, 1979, between the Authority and the United States for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the McGee Creek Project, shall remain in
- 11 (2) AMENDMENTS.—With the consent of the 12 Authority, the Secretary may amend the contract de-13 scribed in paragraph (1) to reflect the conveyance of 14 the land and facilities under subsection (a)(1).
- 15 (e) APPLICABILITY OF THE RECLAMATION LAWS.—
  16 Notwithstanding the conveyance of the land and facilities
  17 under subsection (a)(1), the reclamation laws shall con18 tinue to apply to any project water provided to the Author19 ity.
