**AN ACT**

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 701 Loyola Avenue in New Orleans, Louisiana, as the “Louisiana Armed Services Veterans Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LOUISIANA ARMED SERVICES VETERANS POST**

4 **OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
6 Postal Service located at 701 Loyola Avenue in New Orle-  
7 ans, Louisiana, shall be known and designated as the  
8 “Louisiana Armed Services Veterans Post Office”.

1           (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Louisiana Armed  
5 Services Veterans Post Office”.
