A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to require that, after 5 years, all diesel fuel sold to consumers in the United States for motor vehicles contain not less than 2 percent bio-fuel, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “The Energy Independence
5 through Bio-diesel Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. 2 PERCENT BIO-FUEL REQUIREMENT.**

2 Section 211(o) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
3 7545(o)) is amended by adding the following new para-
4 graph at the end thereof:

5 “(13) 2 PERCENT BIO-FUEL REQUIREMENT.—
6 Not later than 1 year after the enactment of this
7 paragraph, the Administrator shall promulgate regu-
8 lations under this section requiring that, after the
9 date 5 years after the enactment of this paragraph,
10 all diesel motor vehicle fuel sold or dispensed to con-
11 sumers in the contiguous United States, on an an-
12 nual average basis, contain not less than 2 percent
13 biodiesel (as defined in section 312(f)(1) of the En-
14 ergy Policy Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 13220(f)(1)).”.
