A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish an Ombudsman within the Department of Veterans Affairs.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICE OF THE OMBUDS-
- 4 MAN IN DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-
- 5 FAIRS.
- 6 (a) Establishment.—Chapter 3 of title 38, United
- 7 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 8 lowing new section:

1 "§ 321. Office of the Ombudsman

- 2 "(a) In General.—There is established in the De-
- 3 partment an Office of the Ombudsman (in this section re-
- 4 ferred to as the Office). The Secretary shall designate an
- 5 Ombudsman to carry out the duties of the Office.
- 6 "(b) Duties.—The Office shall act as a liaison for
- 7 veterans and their family members with respect to the re-
- 8 ceipt of health care and benefits administered by the De-
- 9 partment.
- 10 "(c) Availability of Services.—The Secretary
- 11 shall ensure that the services of the Office are available
- 12 to all veterans and their family members.
- 13 "(d) Confidentiality.—Any information provided
- 14 by veterans or their family members to the Office may
- 15 be disclosed only to the extent necessary to carry out the
- 16 duties of the Office.
- 17 "(e) Outreach.—The Secretary shall make available
- 18 to each veteran, and to the family members of all veterans,
- 19 information on contacting and utilizing the services of the
- 20 Office.".
- 21 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 22 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
- 23 at the end the following new item:

"321. Office of the Ombudsman.".
