A BILL

To validate certain conveyances made by the Union Pacific Railroad Company of lands located in Reno, Nevada, that were originally conveyed by the United States to facilitate construction of transcontinental railroads, and for other purposes. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. RAILROAD LANDS DEFINED.

For the purposes of this Act, the term "railroad lands"
means those lands within the City of Reno, Nevada, located
within portions of sections 10, 11, and 12 of T.19 N., R.
19 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, that were originally granted to the Union Pacific Railroad under the provisions of the Act of July 1, 1862, commonly known as the
Union Pacific Railroad Act.

11 SEC. 2. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST.

12 Any reversionary interests of the United States (in-13 cluding interests under the Act of July 1, 1862, commonly 14 known as the Union Pacific Railroad Act) in and to the 15 railroad lands as defined in section one of this Act are here-16 by released.

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill to provide for the release of any reversionary interest of the United States in and to certain lands in Reno, Nevada.".
