1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. GEOTHERMAL HEAT PUMP SYSTEMS TREATED 4 AS ENERGY PROPERTY. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (A) of section 48(a)(3) is amended by striking "or" at the end of clause (iii), by inserting "or" at the end of clause (iv), and by 7 8 adding at the end the following new clause: "(v) equipment which uses the ground 9

or ground water as a thermal energy

1	source to heat a structure or as a thermal
2	energy sink to cool a structure,".
3	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
4	this section shall apply to property placed in service after
5	the date of the enactment of this Act.
