## **3** SECTION 1. DENIAL OF RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8312(a) of title 5, United
  5 States Code, is amended—
- 6 (1) by striking "or" at the end of paragraph
  7 (1), by striking the period at the end of paragraph
  8 (2) and inserting "; or", and by inserting after para9 graph (2) the following:

"(3) was convicted of an offense described in
 subsection (d), to the extent provided by that sub section."; and

4 (2) by striking "and" at the end of subpara5 graph (A), by striking the period at the end of sub6 paragraph (B) and inserting "; and", and by insert7 ing after subparagraph (B) the following:

8 "(C) with respect to the offenses described in
9 subsection (d), to the period after the date of convic10 tion.".

(b) OFFENSES DESCRIBED.—Section 8312 of such
title 5 is amended by redesignating subsection (d) as subsection (e), and by inserting after subsection (c) the following:

15 "(d) An offense described in this subsection is any16 offense which is—

17 "(1) within the purview of section 201 (bribery 18 of public officials and witnesses), 203 (compensation 19 to Members of Congress, officers, and others in mat-20 ters affecting the Government), 205 (activities of of-21 ficers and employees in claims against and other 22 matters affecting the Government), 211 (acceptance 23 or solicitation to obtain appointive public office), 641 24 (public money, property or records), 663 (solicitation 25 or use of gifts), 1001 (statements or entries gen-

1	erally), 1621 (perjury generally), 1622 (subornation
2	of perjury), or 1623 (false declarations before grand
3	jury or court) of title 18; and
4	"(2) committed after the date of the enactment
5	of this subsection.".
6	(c) Absence From United States To Avoid
7	PROSECUTION.—Section 8313(a)(1) of such title 5 is
8	amended by striking "or" at the end of subparagraph (A),
9	by striking "and" at the end of subparagraph (B) and
10	inserting "or", and by adding at the end the following:
11	"(C) after the date of the enactment of
12	subsection (d) of section 8312, for an offense
13	described in such subsection; and".
14	(d) Nonaccrual of Interest on Refunds.—Sec-
15	tion 8316(b) of such title 5 is amended by striking "or"
16	at the end of paragraph (1), by striking the period at the
17	end of paragraph (2) and inserting "; or", and by adding
18	at the end the following:
19	"(3) if the individual was convicted of an of-
20	fense described in section 8312(d), for the period

21 after the conviction.".
