Mr. YOUNG of Alaska (for himself and Mr. SALI) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To amend the American Bald Eagle Recovery and National
Emblem Commemorative Coin Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Bald Eagle
5 Commemorative Coin Program Amendments of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISTRIBUTIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (b) of section 7 of the
8 American Bald Eagle Recovery and National Emblem
9 Commemorative Coin Act is amended to read as follows:

1 “(b) DISTRIBUTION.—Subject to section 5134(f) of
2 title 31, United States Code, all surcharges received by
3 the Secretary from the sale of coins issued under this Act
4 shall be promptly paid by the Secretary as follows:

5 “(1) $\frac{1}{3}$ to the American Eagle Foundation of
6 Tennessee in the United States to further its works.

7 “(2) $\frac{1}{3}$ to the American Bald Eagle Founda-
8 tion of Haines, Alaska, to further its works.

9 “(3) $\frac{1}{3}$ to the Peregrine Fund of Boise, Idaho,
10 to further its works.”.

11 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—
12 Subsection (c) of section 7 is amended by striking “United
13 States and the American Eagle Fund” and inserting
14 “United States, the American Eagle Fund, the American
15 Bald Eagle Foundation of Haines, Alaska, and the Per-
16 egrine Fund of Boise, Idaho”.
