## AN ACT

To reauthorize the Underground Railroad Educational and Cultural Program.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

## 1 SECTION 1. UNDERGROUND RAILROAD EDUCATIONAL AND

## CULTURAL PROGRAM.

3 (a) **PROGRAM** ESTABLISHED.—The Secretary of Education, in consultation and cooperation with the Sec-4 5 retary of the Interior, is authorized to make grants to one or more nonprofit educational organizations that are es-6 7 tablished to research, display, interpret, and collect arti-8 facts relating to the history of the Underground Railroad. 9 (b) GRANT AGREEMENT.—Each nonprofit edu-10 cational organization awarded a grant under this section 11 shall enter into an agreement with the Secretary of Edu-12 cation. Each such agreement shall require the organization-13

(1) to establish a facility to house, display, and
interpret the artifacts related to the history of the
Underground Railroad, and to make the interpretive
efforts available to institutions of higher education
that award a baccalaureate or graduate degree;

19 (2) to demonstrate substantial private support 20 for the facility through the implementation of a pub-21 lic-private partnership between a State or local pub-22 lic entity and a private entity for the support of the 23 facility, which private entity shall provide matching 24 funds for the support of the facility in an amount 25 equal to 4 times the amount of the contribution of 26 the State or local public entity, except that not more HR 2707 RFS

1	than 20 percent of the matching funds may be pro-
2	vided by the Federal Government;
3	(3) to create an endowment to fund any and all
4	shortfalls in the costs of the on-going operations of
5	the facility;
6	(4) to establish a network of satellite centers
7	throughout the United States to help disseminate in-
8	formation regarding the Underground Railroad
9	throughout the United States, if such satellite cen-
10	ters raise 80 percent of the funds required to estab-
11	lish the satellite centers from non-Federal public and
12	private sources;
13	(5) to establish the capability to electronically
14	link the facility with other local and regional facili-
15	ties that have collections and programs which inter-
16	pret the history of the Underground Railroad; and
17	(6) to submit, for each fiscal year for which the
18	organization receives funding under this section, a
19	report to the Secretary of Education that contains—
20	(A) a description of the programs and ac-
21	tivities supported by the funding;
22	(B) the audited financial statement of the
23	organization for the preceding fiscal year;

(C) a plan for the programs and activities 1 2 to be supported by the funding as the Secretary 3 may require; and (D) an evaluation of the programs and ac-4 5 tivities supported by the funding as the Sec-6 retary may require. 7 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section 8

9 \$3,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2008 through10 2012.
