AN ACT

- To provide compensation to relatives of United States citizens who were killed as a result of the bombings of United States Embassies in East Africa on August 7, 1998.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Foreign Service Vic-
- 3 tims of Terrorism Act of 2007".
- 4 SEC. 2. DEATH GRATUITY.
- 5 Section 413 of the Foreign Service Act of 1980 (22)
- 6 U.S.C. 3973) is amended—
- 7 (1) in subsection (a), in the first sentence, by
- 8 striking "at the time of death" and inserting "at
- 9 level II of the Executive Schedule at the time of
- death, except that in the case of foreign national em-
- 11 ployees, foreign nationals appointed under section
- 12 303, and locally employed staff the amount shall be
- equal to one year's basic salary at the highest step
- of the highest grade on the local compensation plan
- of the country in which the foreign national or lo-
- cally employed staffer was being paid";
- 17 (2) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-
- 18 section (e); and
- 19 (3) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
- 20 lowing new subsection:
- 21 "(d) In addition to a death gratuity payment under
- 22 subsection (a), the Secretary or the head of the relevant
- 23 United States Government agency is authorized to provide
- 24 for payment to the surviving dependents of a Foreign
- 25 Service employee or a Government executive branch em-
- 26 ployee, if such Foreign Service employee or Government

- 1 executive branch employee is subject to the authority of
- 2 the chief of mission pursuant to section 207, of an amount
- 3 equal to a maximum of eight times the salary of such For-
- 4 eign Service employee or Government executive branch
- 5 employee if such Foreign Service employee or Government
- 6 executive branch employee is killed as a result of an act
- 7 of international terrorism. Such payment shall be accorded
- 8 the same treatment as a payment made under subsection
- 9 (a). For purposes of this subsection, the term 'act of inter-
- 10 national terrorism' has the meaning given such term in
- 11 section 2331(1) of title 18, United States Code.".
- 12 SEC. 3. PAYMENTS TO FAMILIES OF CERTAIN VICTIMS OF
- 13 TERRORISM.
- Subject to the availability of appropriations specifi-
- 15 cally for the purpose specified in this section as provided
- 16 in appropriations Acts enacted on or after October 1,
- 17 2007, and notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 18 Secretary of State shall pay the maximum amount of pay-
- 19 ment under section 413(d) of the Foreign Service Act of
- 20 1980 (as amended by section 2(3) of this Act) to an indi-
- 21 vidual described in such section 413(d) or to an individual
- 22 who was otherwise serving at a United States diplomatic
- 23 or consular mission abroad without a regular salary who
- 24 was killed as a result of an act of international terrorism
- 25 (as such term is defined in section 2331(1) of title 18,

- 1 United States Code) that occurred between January 1,
- 2 1998, and the date of the enactment of this Act, including
- 3 the victims of the bombing of August 7, 1998, in Nairobi,
- 4 Kenya. Such a payment shall be deemed to be a payment
- 5 under section 413(d) of the Foreign Service Act of 1980,
- 6 except that for purposes of this section, such payment
- 7 shall, with respect to a United States citizen receiving pay-
- 8 ment under this section, be in an amount equal to ten
- 9 times the salary specified in this section. For purposes of
- 10 this section and section 413(d) of such Act, with respect
- 11 to a United States citizen receiving payment under this
- 12 section, the salary to be used for purposes of determining
- 13 such payment shall be \$94,000.
