## A BILL

To provide compensation to relatives of United States citizens who were killed as a result of the bombings of United States Embassies in East Africa on August 7, 1998.

3 SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR UNITED STATES CITIZENS
4 WHO WERE VICTIMS OF THE BOMBINGS OF
5 UNITED STATES EMBASSIES IN EAST AFRICA
6 ON AUGUST 7, 1998.
7 (a) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this section is to pro-

vide compensation to relatives of United States citizens

- 1 who were killed as a result of the bombings of United
- 2 States Embassies in East Africa on August 7, 1998.
- 3 (b) Compensation Authorized.—The Secretary of
- 4 State is authorized to provide compensation to the per-
- 5 sonal representative of a decedent who is an eligible indi-
- 6 vidual described in subsection (c).
- 7 (c) Eligible Individuals.—A decedent is an eligi-
- 8 ble individual for purposes of this subsection if the indi-
- 9 vidual was a citizen of the United States who—
- 10 (1) was present at the United States Embassy
- in Nairobi, Kenya, or the United States Embassy in
- Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, at the time, or in the im-
- mediate aftermath, of the bombings of United States
- embassies in East Africa on August 7, 1998; and
- 15 (2) suffered death as a result of such a bomb-
- 16 ing.
- 17 (d) Equitable Distribution.—To the maximum
- 18 extent practicable, the Secretary of State shall ensure an
- 19 equitable distribution of amounts of compensation under
- 20 this section among the personal representatives of dece-
- 21 dents who are eligible individuals described in subsection
- 22 (c).
- (e) Regulations.—The Secretary of State is au-
- 24 thorized to promulgate such regulations as may be nec-
- 25 essary to carry out this section.

- 1 (f) Authorization of Appropriations.—To carry
- 2 out this section, there is authorized to be appropriated to

3 the Secretary of State \$18,000,000.

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
