A BILL

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Insular Areas Energy
- 3 Act of 2007".
- 4 SEC. 2. INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY LOAN GUARANTEE PRO-
- 5 GRAM.
- 6 (a) Section 1703(b) of the Energy Policy Act of 2005
- 7 (42 U.S.C. 16513(b)) is amended by adding at the end
- 8 the following new paragraph:
- 9 "(11) Ocean thermal energy conversion sys-
- tems, whether for the production of electricity, cold
- 11 water cooling, or fresh water, or any combination
- thereof.".
- 13 (b) Section 1703 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005
- 14 (42 U.S.C. 16513) is further amended by adding at the
- 15 end the following new subsection:
- 16 "(f) Geographic Limitations.—The Secretary may
- 17 make guarantees for projects that are located within the
- 18 United States, as well as Guam, American Samoa, the
- 19 Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands, the
- 20 United States Virgin Islands, the Commonwealth of Puer-
- 21 to Rico, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Fed-
- 22 erated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau,
- 23 as well as any United States Government installation
- 24 worldwide, including military bases, embassies, and other
- 25 facilities, whether owned or leased by the United States
- 26 Government, including all areas described in section 638

- 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and all territorial
- 2 waters, seabed, and subsoil of submarine areas adjacent

3 to such installations.".

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
