A BILL

For the relief of Alfredo B. de Perio, Myrna L. de Perio, Allan Rey L. de Perio, and Marc de Perio.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ALFREDO

B. DE PERIO, MYRNA L. DE PERIO, ALLAN REY
L. DE PERIO, AND MARC DE PERIO.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act, Alfredo B. de Perio, Myrna L. de Perio, Allan Rey
9 L. de Perio, and Marc de Perio shall each be eligible for
10 issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status

to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent resi dence upon filing an application for issuance of an immi grant visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment
 of status to lawful permanent resident.

5 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Alfredo B. de Perio, Myrna L. de Perio, Allan Rey L. de Perio, or Marc 6 7 de Perio enters the United States before the filing deadline 8 specified in subsection (c), he or she shall be considered 9 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if other-10 wise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of 11 12 the date of the enactment of this Act.

13 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-14 15 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees 16 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 17 18 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.— 19 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent residence to Alfredo B. de Perio, Myrna L. de Perio, Allan 2021 Rey L. de Perio, and Marc de Perio, the Secretary of State 22 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 4, during the 23 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of 24 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the 25 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the

Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the
 total number of immigrant visas that are made available
 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
 202(e) of such Act.

5 (e) Denial OF Preferential IMMIGRATION TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural 6 parents, brothers, and sisters of Alfredo B. de Perio, 7 Myrna L. de Perio, Allan Rey L. de Perio, and Marc de 8 Perio shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded 9 any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and 10 11 Nationality Act.
