- 3 SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF AUTOMATIC PAY ADJUST-
- 4 MENT FOR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS IN 2008.
- 5 For purposes of the provision of law amended by sec-
- 6 tion 704(a)(2)(B) of the Ethics Reform Act of 1989 (5
- 7 U.S.C. 5318 note), no adjustment under section 5303 of
- 8 title 5, United States Code, shall be considered to have

- 1 taken effect in fiscal year 2008 in the rates of basic pay
- 2 for the statutory pay systems.
