3 **SECTION 1. JOHN HERSCHEL GLENN, JR. POST OFFICE**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 954 Wheeling Avenue in Cam-

1 bridge, Ohio, shall be known and designated as the “John
2 Herschel Glenn, Jr. Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “John Herschel Glenn,
7 Jr. Post Office Building”.
