## A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to limit to class II narcotics the required use of tamper-resistant prescription pads under the Medicaid Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Patient and Pharmacy  
5 Protection Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITING TO CLASS II NARCOTICS THE REQUIRED**  
2 **USE OF TAMPER-RESISTANT PRESCRIPTION**  
3 **PADS UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.**

4 Section 1903(i)(23) of the Social Security Act (42  
5 U.S.C. 1396b(i)(23)), as added by section 7002(a) of the  
6 U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery,  
7 and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007 (Public  
8 Law 110–28), is amended by inserting “which are narcotic  
9 drugs included in schedule II of section 202 of the Con-  
10 trolled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 812) and” after  
11 “1927(k)(2)”.
