A BILL

To provide for the establishment of Federal fleet refueling centers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FEDERAL FLEET FUELING CENTERS.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than January 1, 2010,
- 5 the head of each Federal agency shall install at least 1
- 6 renewable fuel pump at each Federal fleet fueling center
- 7 in the United States under the jurisdiction of the head
- 8 of the Federal agency.
- 9 (b) Report.—Not later than October 31 of the first
- 10 calendar year after the date of enactment of this Act, and
- 11 each October 31 thereafter, the President shall submit to

- 1 Congress a report that describes the progress towards2 complying with subsection (a), including identifying—
- (1) the number of Federal fleet fueling centers
 that contain at least 1 renewable fuel pump; and
- (2) the number of Federal fleet fueling centers
 that do not contain any renewable fuel pumps.
- 7 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There 8 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as are nec-9 essary to carry out this section.
