3 SECTION 1. FEASIBILITY STUDY ON MILITARY IDENTIFICA-4

TION NUMBERS REQUIRED.

(a) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Defense 5 shall conduct a study to determine the feasibility of using 6 a distinct military identification number to identify each 7

member of the Armed Forces instead of using the mem ber's social security number.

3 (b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
5 shall submit to Congress a report containing the findings
6 of the study conducted under subsection (a).
