To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to carry out a competitive grant program for the Puget Sound area to provide comprehensive conservation planning to address water quality.

- 4 SEC. 2. COMPREHENSIVE CONSERVATION PLANNING FOR

- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture shall
- 7 carry out a competitive grant program for the Puget
- 8 Sound area to provide comprehensive conservation plan-
- 9 ning to address water quality. The Secretary shall enter
- 10 into cooperative agreements with State and local govern-
- 11 ments, Indian tribes, or non-governmental entities with a
- 12 history of working with agricultural producers to carry out

- 14 (b) Assistance.—In carrying out the program, the

- (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is

- 1 for each of fiscal years 2008 through 2012 to carry out
