To provide authority to the Peace Corps to provide separation pay for host country resident personal services contractors of the Peace Corps.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR PEACE CORPS TO PRO4 VIDE SEPARATION PAY FOR HOST COUNTRY
5 RESIDENT PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRAC6 TORS OF THE PEACE CORPS.
7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF FUND.—There is estab8 lished in the Treasury of the United States a fund for

the Peace Corps to provide separation pay for host country

10 resident personal services contractors of the Peace Corps.

1	(b) Funding.—The Director of the Peace Corps may
2	deposit in the fund established under subsection (a)—
3	(1) amounts previously obligated and not can-
4	celed to provide the separation pay described in such
5	subsection; and
6	(2) amounts obligated for fiscal years after fis-
7	cal year 2006 for current and future costs of pro-
8	viding such separation pay.
9	(c) Availability.—Beginning in fiscal year 2007,
10	amounts deposited in the fund established under sub-
11	section (a) shall be available without fiscal year limitation
12	for severance, retirement, or other separation payments to
13	host country resident personal services contractors of the
14	Peace Corps in countries where such payments are legally
15	authorized.

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
