AN ACT

To provide authority to the Peace Corps to provide separation pay for host country resident personal services contractors of the Peace Corps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR PEACE CORPS TO PRO-**
2 **VIDE SEPARATION PAY FOR HOST COUNTRY**
3 **RESIDENT PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRAC-**
4 **TORS OF THE PEACE CORPS.**

5 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT OF FUND.**—There is estab-
6 lished in the Treasury of the United States a fund for
7 the Peace Corps to provide separation pay for host country
8 resident personal services contractors of the Peace Corps.

9 (b) **FUNDING.**—The Director of the Peace Corps may
10 deposit in the fund established under subsection (a)—

11 (1) amounts previously obligated and not can-
12 celed to provide the separation pay described in such
13 subsection; and

14 (2) amounts obligated for fiscal years after fis-
15 cal year 2006 for current and future costs of pro-
16 viding such separation pay.

17 (c) **AVAILABILITY.**—Beginning in fiscal year 2007,
18 amounts deposited in the fund established under sub-
19 section (a) shall be available without fiscal year limitation
20 for severance, retirement, or other separation payments to
21 host country resident personal services contractors of the

- 1 Peace Corps in countries where such payments are legally
- 2 authorized.
