A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER AARON WEAVER**
2 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 1400 Highway 41 North in In-
5 verness, Florida, shall be known and designated as the
6 “Chief Warrant Officer Aaron Weaver Post Office Build-
7 ing”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “Chief Warrant Officer
12 Aaron Weaver Post Office Building”.
