A BILL

To amend the "Do-not-call" Implementation Act to eliminate the automatic removal of telephone numbers registered on the Federal "do-not-call" registry.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Do-Not-Call Improve-
- 5 ment Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF EXPIRATION DATE FOR REG-
- 7 ISTERED TELEPHONE NUMBERS.
- 8 The "Do-not-call" Implementation Act (15 U.S.C.
- 9 6101 note) is amended—

1	(1) in section 3, after the first sentence, by in-
2	serting the following: "Such rule shall not provide
3	any date of expiration for telephone numbers reg-
4	istered on the 'do-not-call' registry, nor for any pre-
5	determined time limitation for telephone numbers to
6	remain on the registry."; and

(2) by adding at the end the following:

8 "SEC. 5. PROHIBITION OF EXPIRATION DATE.

"In issuing regulations regarding the 'do-not-call' registry of the Telemarketing Sales Rule (16 C.F.R. 310.4(b)(1)(iii)), the Federal Trade Commission shall not provide for any date of expiration for telephone numbers registered on the 'do-not-call' registry, nor for any predetermined time limitation for telephone numbers to remain on the registry.".
