A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to authorize appropriations for the Administrative Conference of the United States through fiscal year 2011, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Regulatory Improve-
3 ment Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

5 Section 596 of title 5, United States Code, is amend-
6 ed to read as follows:

7 **“§ 596. Authorization of appropriations**

8 “There are authorized to be appropriated to carry out
9 this subchapter not more than \$1,000,000 for fiscal year
10 2008, \$3,300,000 for fiscal year 2009, \$3,400,000 for fis-
11 cal year 2010, and \$3,500,000 for fiscal year 2011. Of
12 any amounts appropriated under this section, not more
13 than \$2,500 may be made available in each fiscal year for
14 official representation and entertainment expenses for for-
15 eign dignitaries.”.
