A BILL

To provide for the sale of approximately 25 acres of public land to the Turnabout Ranch, Escalante, Utah, at fair market value.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

- 4 In this Act:
- 5 (1) FEDERAL LAND.—The term "Federal land"
 6 means the approximately 25 acres of Bureau of
 7 Land Management land identified on the map as
 8 "Lands to be conveyed to Turnabout Ranch".
- 9 (2) MAP.—The term "map" means the map en10 titled "Turnabout Ranch Conveyance" dated May

1	12, 2006, and on file in the office of the Director
2	of the Bureau of Land Management.
3	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
4	the Secretary of the Interior.
5	(4) MONUMENT.—The term "Monument"
6	means the Grand Staircase-Escalante National
7	Monument located in southern Utah.
8	(5) TURNABOUT RANCH.—The term "Turn-
9	about Ranch' means the Turnabout Ranch in
10	Escalante, Utah, owned by Aspen Education Group.
11	SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF FEDERAL LAND TO TURNABOUT
12	RANCH.
13	(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the land use
14	planning requirements of sections 202 and 203 of the Fed-

eral Land Policy and Management Act (43 U.S.C. 1713), 15 if not later than 30 days after completion of the appraisal 16 required under subsection (b), Turnabout Ranch of 17 Escalante, Utah submits to the Secretary an offer to ac-18 19 quire the Federal land for the appraised value, the Secretary shall, not later than 30 days after the date of the 20 offer, convey to Turnabout Ranch all right, title, and in-21 22 terest to the Federal land, subject to valid existing rights. 23 (b) APPRAISAL.—Not later than 90 days after the

24 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall complete25 an appraisal of the Federal land. The appraisal shall be

completed in accordance with the "Uniform Appraisal
 Standards for Federal Land Acquisitions" and the "Uni form Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice". All
 costs associated with the appraisal shall be born by Turn about Ranch.

6 (c) PAYMENT OF CONSIDERATION.—Not later than 7 30 days after the date on which the Federal land is con-8 veyed under subsection (a), as a condition of the convey-9 ance, Turnabout Ranch shall pay to the Secretary an 10 amount equal to the appraised value of the Federal land, 11 as determined under subsection (b).

(d) COSTS OF CONVEYANCE.—As a condition of the
conveyance, any costs of the conveyance under subsection
(a) shall be paid by Turnabout Ranch.

(e) DISPOSITION OF PROCEEDS.—The Secretary
shall deposit the proceeds from the conveyance of the Federal land under subsection (a) in the Federal Land Deposit Account established by section 206 of the Federal
Land Transaction Facilitation Act, Public Law 106–248,
to be expended in accordance with that Act.

21 SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF MONUMENT BOUNDARY.

When the conveyance authorized by section 2 is completed, the boundaries of the Grand Staircase-Escalante
National Monument in the State of Utah are hereby modi-

1 fied to exclude the Federal land conveyed to Turnabout

2 Ranch.
