A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to facilitate the temporary reemployment of Federal annuitants, and for other purposes.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

 SECTION 1. TEMPORARY REEMPLOYMENT OF ANNUITANTS.

 (a) CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—Section

"(2) An annuitant may not, under authority of this 5 6 subsection, be excluded from the application of subsection 7 (a) or (b) (as the case may be) with respect to more 8 than— 9 "(A) 520 hours of service performed by such 10 annuitant during the period ending 6 months after 11 the date on which the annuity of such annuitant 12 commences; 13 "(B) 1,040 hours of service performed by such 14 annuitant during any 12-month period; or "(C) 6,240 hours of service performed by such 15 16 annuitant during the lifetime of such annuitant. 17 "(3) The Director of the Office of Personnel Management may prescribe any regulations necessary for the ad-18 19 ministration of this subsection.". 20 (b) Federal Employees' Retirement System.— 21 Section 8468 of title 5, United States Code, is amended— 22 (1) by redesignating subsection (i) as subsection 23 (j); and 24 (2) by inserting after subsection (h) the fol-
