A BILL

To make permanent the waiver authority of the Secretary of Education with respect to student financial assistance during a war or other military operation or national emergency.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SENSE OF CONGRESS.
- 4 It is the sense of Congress that—
- 5 (1) the Higher Education Relief Opportunities
- 6 for Students Act of 2003 addresses the unique situa-
- 7 tions that active duty military personnel and other
- 8 affected individuals may face in connection with

- their enrollment in postsecondary institutions and
 their Federal student loans; and
- 3 (2) the provisions authorized by such Act 4 should be made permanent, thereby allowing the 5 Secretary of Education to continue providing assist-6 ance to active duty service members and other af-
- 7 fected individuals and their families.

8 SEC. 2. PERMANENT EXTENSION OF WAIVER AUTHORITY.

- 9 The Higher Education Relief Opportunities for Stu-
- 10 dents Act of 2003 (Public Law 108–76; 20 U.S.C. 1070,
- 11 note) is amended by striking section 6.
