## A BILL

To prohibit the collection of tolls on highways, bridges, and  
tunnels constructed using Federal funds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Toll Road Prohibition  
5 Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON COLLECTION OF TOLLS.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, after the  
8 date of enactment of this Act, no toll may be collected  
9 for the use of a highway, bridge, or tunnel constructed

1 (as defined in section 101 of title 23, United States Code)  
2 in whole or in part using Federal funds unless the total  
3 amount of such Federal funds, including reasonable inter-  
4 est thereon, is repaid to the United States from non-Fed-  
5 eral sources.
