Mr. BISHOP of Utah introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on Natural Resources

## A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of parcels of land to Mantua,  
Box Elder County, Utah.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Box Elder Utah Land  
5       Conveyance Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN LANDS TO MANTUA, BOX**  
7       **ELDER, UTAH.**

8       (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Ag-  
9       riculture shall convey, without consideration, to the city  
10      of Mantua, Utah (in this section referred to as the “city”),

1 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and  
2 to parcels of National Forest System land in Box Elder  
3 County, Utah, consisting of approximately 31.5 acres  
4 within section 27, township 9 north, range 1 west, Salt  
5 Lake meridian and labeled as parcels A, B, and C on the  
6 accompanying map.

7 (b) SURVEY.—If necessary, the exact acreage and  
8 legal description of the lands to be conveyed under sub-  
9 section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory  
10 to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be borne  
11 by the city.

12 (c) REPORT.—If the Secretary has not completed the  
13 conveyance required under subsection (a) within 12  
14 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
15 Secretary shall submit to Congress a report that explains  
16 the reason such conveyance has not been completed and  
17 stating the date by which the conveyance will be com-  
18 pleted.

19 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The  
20 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-  
21 tions in connection with the conveyance authorized under  
22 subsection (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to  
23 protect the interests of the United States.
