# A BILL

Making appropriations to the Department of Transportation to repair and reconstruct the bridge that collapsed on August 1, 2007, on Interstate Route I–35W in Minneapolis, Minnesota, for the year ending September 30, 2008.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Minnesota Bridge Re-
- 5 pair Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. BRIDGE COLLAPSE ASSISTANCE.

- 2 There are hereby appropriated, out of any funds in
- 3 the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the Secretary
- 4 of Transportation \$195,000,000, to remain available until
- 5 expended, for emergency repairs and reconstruction of the
- 6 bridge that collapsed on August 1, 2007, on Interstate
- 7 Route I–35W in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

## 8 SEC. 3. OFFSETTING ACROSS-THE-BOARD RESCISSION.

- 9 (a) In General.—Of the amount of new discre-
- 10 tionary budget authority provided for fiscal year 2008 in
- 11 any fiscal year 2008 appropriation Act (other than for the
- 12 Department of Defense, Homeland Security, or Veterans
- 13 Affairs), there is rescinded the total amount determined
- 14 by the Director of the Office of Management and Budget
- 15 to be required to offset the new discretionary budget au-
- 16 thority provided in this Act.
- 17 (b) Proportionate Application.—The rescission
- 18 under subsection (a) shall be applied proportionately to
- 19 each discretionary account, and to each program, project,
- 20 and activity within each such account.
- 21 (c) OMB REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after the
- 22 date of enactment of this section, the Director of the Of-
- 23 fice of Management and Budget shall submit to the Com-
- 24 mittees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives
- 25 and the Senate a report specifying each account reduced

- 1 by the rescission under this section and the amount of
- 2 such reduction.

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
