- 4 (a) Funding.—In carrying out its Energy for Sus-
- 5 tainability program, the National Science Foundation may
- 6 accept and use funds contributed by the Department of
- 7 Energy from the Energy Efficiency and Renewable En-

- 1 ergy program, to support projects that enable related re-
- 2 search and development activities within these programs.
- 3 (b) Consultation.—The Director of the National
- 4 Science Foundation shall consult with the Assistant Sec-
- 5 retary of Energy for Energy Efficiency and Renewable
- 6 Energy when preparing solicitations for projects described
- 7 in subsection (a).
