A BILL

To amend the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation Establishment Act to increase the number of Directors on the Board of Directors of the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Fish and
5 Wildlife Foundation Establishment Act Amendment of
6 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FOUNDATION.**

2 Section 3(a) of the National Fish and Wildlife Foun-
3 dation Establishment Act (16 U.S.C. 3702(a)) is amended
4 by striking paragraph (1) and inserting the following:

5 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Foundation shall have
6 a governing Board of Directors (referred to in this
7 Act as the ‘Board’), which shall consist of 30 Direc-
8 tors appointed in accordance with subsection (b),
9 each of whom shall be a United States citizen.”.
