## AN ACT

To temporarily extend the programs under the Higher  
Education Act of 1965, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Third Higher Edu-  
3 cation Extension Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.**

5 Section 2(a) of the Higher Education Extension Act  
6 of 2005 (Public Law 109–81; 20 U.S.C. 1001 note) is  
7 amended by striking “October 31, 2007” and inserting  
8 “April 30, 2008”.

9 **SEC. 3. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

10 Nothing in this Act, or in the Higher Education Ex-  
11 tension Act of 2005 as amended by this Act, shall be con-  
12 strued to limit or otherwise alter the authorizations of ap-  
13 propriations for, or the durations of, programs contained  
14 in the amendments made by the Higher Education Rec-  
15 onciliation Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–171) and the  
16 College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007 (Public  
17 Law 110-84) to the provisions of the Higher Education  
18 Act of 1965 and the Taxpayer-Teacher Protection Act of  
19 2004.
