1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Third Higher Edu-
- 3 cation Extension Act of 2007".

4 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.

- 5 Section 2(a) of the Higher Education Extension Act
- 6 of 2005 (Public Law 109–81; 20 U.S.C. 1001 note) is
- 7 amended by striking "October 31, 2007" and inserting
- 8 "April 30, 2008".

9 SEC. 3. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.

- Nothing in this Act, or in the Higher Education Ex-
- 11 tension Act of 2005 as amended by this Act, shall be con-
- 12 strued to limit or otherwise alter the authorizations of ap-
- 13 propriations for, or the durations of, programs contained
- 14 in the amendments made by the Higher Education Rec-
- 15 onciliation Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–171) and the
- 16 College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007 (Public
- 17 Law 110-84) to the provisions of the Higher Education
- 18 Act of 1965 and the Taxpayer-Teacher Protection Act of
- 19 2004.
