1 **SECTION 1. MARINE CORPS CORPORAL STEVEN P. GILL**
2 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 797 Sam Bass Road in Round
5 Rock, Texas, shall be known and designated as the “Ma-
6 rine Corps Corporal Steven P. Gill Post Office Building”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Marine Corps Cor-
11 poral Steven P. Gill Post Office Building”.
