3 SECTION 1. MESOTRIONE.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking heading 9902.25.80; and

8 (2) in heading 9902.11.03, by striking the date
9 in the effective period column and inserting "12/31/
10 2011".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made bysubsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- $2 \ \ {\rm the \ date \ of \ the \ enactment \ of \ this \ Act.}$
