**AN ACT**

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 3050 Hunsinger Lane in Louisville, Kentucky, as the “Iraq and Afghanistan Fallen Military Heroes of Louisville Memorial Post Office Building”, in honor of the servicemen and women from Louisville, Kentucky, who died in service during Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN FALLEN MILITARY**  
2 **HEROES OF LOUISVILLE MEMORIAL POST OF-**  
3 **FICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 3050 Hunsinger Lane in Louis-  
6 ville, Kentucky, shall be known and designated as the  
7 “Iraq and Afghanistan Fallen Military Heroes of Louis-  
8 ville Memorial Post Office Building”.

9 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
10 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
11 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
12 be deemed to be a reference to the “Iraq and Afghanistan  
13 Fallen Military Heroes of Louisville Memorial Post Office  
14 Building”.
