## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on 2-Hydroxypropylmethylcellulose.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 2-HYDROXYPROPYLMETHYLCELLULOSE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.____	2-Hydroxypropylmethyl cellulose containing a hydroxypropyl content between 7–17% by weight, a methoxyl content between 28–30% by weight, and viscosity of 30–70 cps (CAS No. 9004–65–3) (provided for in subheading 3912.39.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2012	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
