

In the Senate of the United States,

September 25 (legislative day, September 17), 2008.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 5057) entitled “An Act to reauthorize the Debbie Smith DNA Backlog Grant Program, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 ***SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.***

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Debbie Smith Reauthor-*
3 *ization Act of 2008”.*

4 ***SEC. 2. GENERAL REAUTHORIZATION.***

5 *Section 2 of the DNA Analysis Backlog Elimination*
6 *Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 14135) is amended—*

7 *(1) in subsection (c)(3), by—*

8 *(A) striking subparagraphs (A) through*

9 *(D);*

1 (B) redesignating subparagraph (E) and
2 subparagraph (A); and

3 (C) inserting at the end the following:

4 “(B) For each of the fiscal years 2010
5 through 2014, not less than 40 percent of the
6 grant amounts shall be awarded for purposes
7 under subsection (a)(2).”; and

8 (2) by amending subsection (j) to read as follows:

9 “(j) *AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.*—There are
10 authorized to be appropriated to the Attorney General for
11 grants under subsection (a) \$151,000,000 for each of fiscal
12 years 2009 through 2014.”.

13 **SEC. 3. TRAINING AND EDUCATION.**

14 Section 303(b) of the DNA Sexual Assault Justice Act
15 of 2004 (42 U.S.C. 14136(b)) is amended by striking “2005
16 through 2009” and inserting “2009 through 2014”.

17 **SEC. 4. SEXUAL ASSAULT FORENSIC EXAM GRANTS.**

18 Section 304(c) of the DNA Sexual Assault Justice Act
19 of 2004 (42 U.S.C. 14136a(c)) is amended by striking
20 “2005 through 2009” and inserting “2009 through 2014”.
