4	Section 101 of the Family and Medical Leave Act of
5	1993 (29 U.S.C. 2611) is amended—
6	(1) in paragraph (2), by adding at the end the
7	following:
8	"(D) Special rule for family mem-
9	BERS OF COVERED SERVICEMEMBERS.—Not-
10	withstanding subparagraph (A), in the case of
11	an individual who is a spouse, parent, son, or
12	daughter of a covered servicemember, such indi-
13	vidual shall be considered an eligible employee
14	for purposes of taking leave under section
15	102(a)(1)(C) in order to care for the covered
16	servicemember, if the individual has been em-
17	ployed for at least 625 hours of service with an
18	employer."; and
19	(2) by adding at the end the following:
20	"(14) Covered Servicemember.—The term
21	'covered servicemember' means a member of the
22	Armed Forces, including a member of the National
23	Guard or a Reserve, who is undergoing medical
24	treatment, recuperation, or therapy, is otherwise in
25	medical hold or medical holdover status, or is other-
