3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN STAPLE FIBERS OF VISCOSE RAYON,

4 CARDED, COMBED, OR OTHERWISE PROC-5 ESSED FOR SPINNING.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.34 of the Har-7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to 8 certain staple fibers of viscose rayon, carded, combed, or 9 otherwise processed for spinning) is amended by striking 10 "12/31/2009" and inserting "12/31/2011". (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
the date of the enactment of this Act.
