Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. STAPLE FIBERS OF VISCOSE RAYON, NOT
 CARDED, COMBED, OR OTHERWISE PROC ESSED FOR SPINNING.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.59 of the Har7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 staple fibers of viscose rayon, not carded, combed, or oth9 erwise processed for spinning) is amended by striking "12/
10 31/2009" and inserting "12/31/2011".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 the date of the enactment of this Act.
