1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHEMICAL USED IN THE PRODUCTION OF TEX-**

4 **TILES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	4,11- Triphenodioxazinedisulfonic acid, 6,13-dichloro-3,10- bis[[2-[[4-fluoro-6-[(2- sulfophenyl)amino]-1,3,5- triazin-2- yl]amino]propyl]amino]-, lith- ium sodium salt (CAS No. 163062-28-0) (provided for in subheading 3204.16.30) ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
