To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into a long-term lease with the Government of the United States Virgin Islands to provide land on the island of Saint John, Virgin Islands, for the establishment of a school, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Virgin Islands National
- 5 Park School Lease Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. LONG-TERM LEASE, VIRGIN ISLANDS NATIONAL
- 7 PARK, SAINT JOHN, VIRGIN ISLANDS.
- 8 (a) Lease Authorized.—The Secretary of the Inte-
- 9 rior may lease to the Government of the United States Vir-
- 10 gin Islands a parcel of real property, including any im-
- 11 provements thereon, located within the boundaries of Virgin
- 12 Islands National Park on the island of Saint John, Virgin
- 13 Islands, as depicted on the map entitled "Virgin Islands
- 14 National Park School Exchange", numbered 161/80,037,
- 15 and dated September 19, 2007, for the purpose of providing
- 16 a suitable location for the establishment of a school by the
- 17 Government of the United States Virgin Islands on the is-
- 18 *land*.
- 19 (b) Term of Lease.—The lease authorized by sub-
- 20 section (a) may not exceed a term of 99 years.
- 21 (c) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map referred to in
- 22 subsection (a) shall be on file and available for public in-
- 23 spection in the appropriate offices of the National Park
- 24 Service.

- 1 (d) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The Sec-
- 2 retary may require such additional terms and conditions
- 3 in connection with the lease under this section as the Sec-
- 4 retary considers appropriate to protect the interests of the
- 5 United States.
