6 Schedule of the United States are each amended by strik7 ing the date in the effective period column and inserting
8 "12/31/2011".

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
